Warwick Morris joined the Diplomatic Service in 1969 and from 1975-76, he undertook Korean language training at Yonsei University in Seoul, taking up his position as Second Secretary in the Embassy from 1977-79. In 1988 he returned to Seoul as Head of Political Affairs until 1991. In November 2003, he was appointed British Ambassador to the Republic of Korea.

The **Korean Ambassador to the UK, Dr Cho Yoon-Je** will be present, making this a unique occasion to have the chance to talk to both Ambassadors.
