Like sarangbang's original usage in olden days, a Korean Village is the place where everyone can come by to experience dynamic Korean culture and creativity with the guarantee of a smile for all visitors.

The Korean Village will host an exciting programme of performances, workshops, traditional foods and crafts, provided by the Korean Cultural Centre, UK.

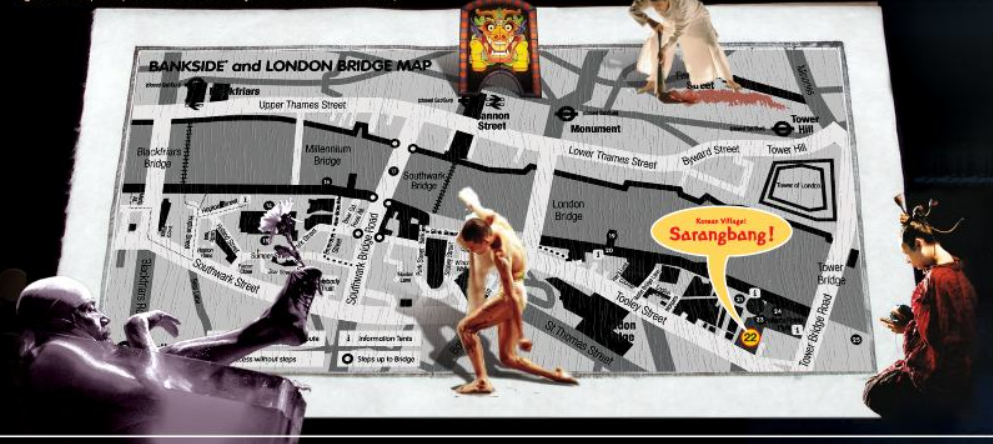
